Step 1: Take out the packing carton and unpack it.









Step 2: Take out the parts.




Step 3: Take out the cooling unit



Step 4.1: Take out the back & side panel and unfold it.




Step 4.2: Put the back & side panel on the cooling unit from back to front.



Step 4.3: As shown in Figure 1-1.1, pull the power cord out of the vent of the back panel.

As shown in Figure 1-1.2, insert the bolt of the back panel into the corresponding hole of the cooling unit.

As shown in Figure 1-1.3 and 1-1.4, insert the clamp strip to the side edge of the cooling unit and side panel

Step 4 The effect is shown in the below figures.





Step 5.1: Take out the shelf support strips.



Step 5.2: Insert the shelf support strip as shown in Figure 2-1.1 1~2-1.4.

Step 5.3: Complete 6 support strips as described above, and the effect is shown in the figure.



Step 6.1: Take out the top panel.



Step 6.2: Remove all Velcro film.



Step 6.3: Bend along the crease as shown in the below figures.



Step 6.4: Paste the edge of the top panel along a straight line



Step 6.4 The effect is shown in the below figures.



Step 6.5: Bend the front end of the top panel.



Step 6.6: Paste the front end of the inner top panel, and the upper end and the front end are flat with the main back panel as shown in the figure.





Step 7.1: Take out the back EVA cotton.



Step 7.2: Insert the EVA cotton into back panel as shown in the below figure






Step 8.1: Take out the top panel.



Step 8.2: Remove the Velcro film.




Step 8.3: Bend the top panel along the crease as shown in the figure, and stick the side of the top panel flat with the back



Step 8.3 The effect is shown in the below figure.



Step 8.4: Align the hole of the top panel with the bolt as shown in the figure and put it into the empty position of the top panel.

Step 9.1: Take out the shelves.



Step 9.2: Put them on the shelf support strips, and align the buckles with the buckle holes.



Step 9.3: Insert the shelves into the back panel.




Step 9: The effect is shown in the below figure.
